Notes to the Test Administrators English (Grade 6-8)

This test is to find out whether the students are at the right level of the respective grades or not. It is to be administered to the whole group. Make sure that you have enough copies for your students. Please read the following guidelines:

i) First motivate your students by saying the following text in the box.

- iii) After the first question, let students write on their own.
- iv) Keep on encouraging students to write.
- v) Keep the following points into consideration while administering the test:
 - Students should also be told the nature, length and means of expressing the answers (written or oral) of the questions.
 - In order to maintain the reliability of the test, it should be managed so that there are two students on one bench, and it should be ensured that no one helps the students to answer the questions.
 - Identify and be familiar with the test delivery method required by the questions in the instrument.
 - Do not let students talk students to each other.
 - Adhere to the allotted time for the test, but a student should be given 5 to 10 minutes more time in special cases.
